

Information clause for the tenderers

In accordance with Article 13 paragraph 1 and 2 of GDPR¹ we inform that:

1. Kołobrzeg Fish Producers Group Limited Liability Company
Węgorzowa 8, 78-100 Kołobrzeg, registered in the National Court Register No. 0000234212, Company Registration Number (REGON) 320047293, Tax identification number (NIP) 6711716546, e-mail: biuro@kgpr.pl, phone: +48 943516490 – is the administrator of your data, hereinafter called the Administrator;
2. Your personal data will be processed for purposes related to conducting and concluding the tender procedure, on the basis of Article 6 paragraph 1 letter a and c and Article 9 paragraph 2 letter b of GDPR;
3. Your personal data may be made available to following categories of entities:
 - 1) public authorities in accordance with the obligations arising from mandatory legal provisions and the grant agreement,
 - 2) the Administrator's counterparties, to the extent necessary for the implementation of agreements,
 - 3) the Administrator's contractors, to the extent necessary for the implementation of agreements,
 - 4) the Administrator's subcontractors, in particular accounting, legal and IT companies;
4. The Administrator does not intend to transfer your data to a third party or international organisations;
5. Your personal data will not be kept longer than necessary, that is for the period of 5 years starting from the date of completion of the tender procedure, unless otherwise provided by mandatory legal provisions.
6. You have the right to access your personal data and the right to rectify, delete, limit their processing, the right to transfer the data, the right to object and with regard to the data which is provided on voluntary basis, the right to withdraw the consent to their processing at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal. A statement of withdrawal of consent to the processing of personal data requires a submission in written or electronic form to the e-mail address biuro@kgpr.pl;
7. You have the right to lodge a complaint to the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection, if you consider that the processing of your personal data infringes the provisions of GDPR;
8. Provision of your personal data is always voluntary, but necessary for the purposes related to conducting of the tender procedure;
9. Your personal data will not be subject to processes in which automated decision-making, including profiling, would occur.
